INTRODUCTION TO MATERIALS TESTING: STATIC

This course is designed to introduce students to the world of materials testing. Discussion includes the importance of testing, needs and reasons for testing, and tests typically used in the application of electromechanical tensile testing systems. Students learn about materials testing while observing actual tests. Course highlights basics of materials testing including mechanical properties, load/elongation test curves, and different types of testing, stress and strain, modulus, yield, preset point calculations, and application testing.

BLUEHILL UNIVERSAL OPERATORS COURSE

In this two-day course, students will work with a certified Instron training instructor to explore the various tools and features of Bluehill Universal. Using a hands-on approach, the instructor will guide students through a series of realistic projects designed to prepare them for the unique demands of their respective laboratories.

In this two-day course, students will work with a certified Instron training instructor to explore the various tools and features of Bluehill 3. Students will learn and apply the best practices for working with Bluehill 3, while exploring topics such as Creating Measurements, Calculations domains, and analysis. Working at individual computer stations, students will learn to create test applications, run tests, generate results, and more.
